Department of Defense LEO Acclaimed for Stopping Gunman at Fort Hood

As Chairman of the FOP Federal Officers Committee I would like to acknowledge the actions of the officer who many are now proclaiming to be the "Hero of Fort Hood." Sgt. Kimberly Munley, a civilian series 0083 Police Officer, is credited with stopping the actions of the shooter who slaughtered over a dozen personnel and wounded scores more. Sgt. Munley is the typical "DOD Police Officer" as they would like to have "In case of emergency break glass."
